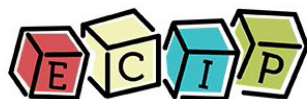

Early Childhood Intervention Program

The Early Childhood Intervention Program (ECIP) is a provincial network of home and community based services provided to families with children from birth to school-age who experience or are at risk for developmental delays. ECIPs work to enhance child development, support families and enhance community connections.

ECIP organizations share the vision that:

“All families have the capacity to meet the developmental needs of their children within the community of their choice.”



Connecting with ECIP

Contact your local ECIP to make a referral by phone, website or in-person. Families can refer themselves or can be referred by anyone in the community with consent of the family.



Services are free of charge

The Early Childhood Intervention Program is funded through the Ministry of Education, Indigenous Services Canada, and other sources.

Services offered

- **Child Development**
 - * Developmental screening
 - * Individual goals for each child developed by the family and ECIP
- **Family Support**
 - * Regular visits to the home or other location as determined by the guardian
 - * Coordinate resources
- **Community Connections**
 - * Assisting families to access other community services
 - * Transitioning to other programs
