

Early Childhood Intervention Program

The Early Childhood Intervention Program (ECIP) is a provincial network of home and community based services provided to families with children from birth to school-age who experience or are at risk for developmental delays. ECIPs work to enhance child development, support families and enhance community connections.

ECIP organizations share the vision that:

"All families have the capacity to meet the developmental needs of their children within the community of their choice."



Connecting with ECIP

Contact your local ECIP to make a referral by phone, website or in-person. Families can refer themselves or can be referred by anyone in the community with consent of the family.



Services offered

- Child Development
 - * Developmental screening
 - Individual goals for each child developed by the family and ECIP
- Family Support
 - Regular visits to the home or other location as determined by the guardian
 - * Coordinate resources
- Community Connections
 - Assisting families to access other community services
 - * Transitioning to other programs

Services are free of charge
